THE KMART CORPORATION JOINT FEE REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT REGARDING CERTAIN FINAL FEE APPLICATIONS

The Kmart Corporation Joint Fee Review Committee (the "Committee") established in the above-captioned cases of Kmart Corporation and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, "Kmart"), hereby submits this report (the "Fee Report") with respect to the Final Fee Applications (the "Applications") filed by those certain professionals (the "Professionals") and the request for reimbursement of expenses by certain committee members (the "Committee Members") listed on the Notice of Hearing on Final Fee Applications, which Notice is attached hereto as *Exhibit A*.

1. On March 20, 2002, this Court entered an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) and 331 Establishing a Joint Fee Review Committee (the "Joint Fee Review Order"). In accordance with the Joint Fee Review Order, there are five (5) voting members of the Committee: (i) Ira Bodenstein, the United States Trustee for the Northern District of Illinois; (ii) William Crowley, the Representative of the Financial

Institutions Committee; (iii) Gary Shapiro, the representative of the Official Unsecured Creditors Committee; (iv) James E. Defebaugh, Kmart's representative; and (v) Tom Zielecki, Kmart's representative. On June 3, 2003, the Court entered an Order Under 11 U.S.C. §327(a) Authorizing the Employment and Retention of Stuart, Maue, Mitchell & James, Ltd. ("Stuart Maue") as the Fee Examiner in these cases (the "Stuart Maue Retention Order").

- 2. The Committee, in consultation with Stuart Maue, developed the Kmart Billing and Expense Guidelines (hereinafter referred to as the "Expense Guidelines", and, collectively, the "Guidelines") to assist the Committee in reviewing the compensation and expense reimbursement requests. A copy of the Guidelines is attached hereto as *Exhibit B*. The Committee believes that these Guidelines are consistent with case law, as well as local rules.
- 3. The Committee directed Stuart Maue to review the Applications filed by Professionals requesting reimbursement of fees on an hourly basis for compliance with these Guidelines. Stuart Maue did not review the Applications filed by Professionals requesting reimbursement of fees on a flat fee basis. Stuart Maue submitted all reports to the Committee by September 15, 2003. On September 22, 2003, the Committee met in Chicago to discuss the reports. At this meeting, each Professional's report was discussed, areas of concern were identified as well as any further information required by the Committee. By letters dated as of October 6, 2003, the Committee advised the Professionals of its concerns regarding their Applications, and, further, requested that each Professional submit an expense affidavit, which affidavit attested to the firm's compliance with the Expense Guidelines (the "Expense Affidavit"). The Professionals

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were also given the opportunity to obtain the complete Stuart Maue report, including exhibits, for their Application.

4. On November 17, 2003, the Committee met with each hourly rate Professional to discuss the Stuart Maue report, their responses to the October 6, 2003 letter, as well as the Expense Affidavits. There were also various additional discussions and meetings between the Professionals and the Committee. As a result of these meetings, the Committee reached a number of settlements, which settlements were approved by this Court on December 17, 2003. Since that date, the Committee has reached the following additional settlements:²

A. Winston & Strawn ("Winston")

Winston is requesting \$2,373,287.85 in fees and \$257,057.52 in expenses. Winston submitted an Expense Affidavit to the Committee attesting to its compliance with the Expense Guidelines except for \$3,850.34 for working meals, \$1,102.48 for out-of-town lodging which exceeded the rate presumed reasonable in the Guidelines, and \$199.82 for business meals. The Sutart Maue report indicates there is significant time expense incurred for vaguely described tasks, lumped entries, multiple attendance, potential duplication of effort and the stewardship investigation. The Committee recommends that Winston's fees be reduced by \$204,764.80 and its expenses be reduced by \$5,152.64 as an appropriate

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The agreements between the Committee and the Professionals which are recommended to the Court in this Fee Report are in settlement of all issues regarding the Applications, subject to final approval by this Court. The Professionals reserve the right to request payment of all fees and expenses in the event that the Applications, as modified by this Report, are not approved by this Court. In such event, these settlements become null and void.

compromise of all issues regarding Winston's fees and expenses. Winston has agreed to these reductions. Accordingly, the Committee respectfully recommends to the Court that Winston be awarded final compensation in the amount of \$2,168,523.02 and expenses in the amount of \$251,904.88.

B. Saybrook Capital LLC ("Saybrook")

Saybrook is requesting \$1,192,258.06 in fees and \$93,504.88 in expenses. Saybrook submitted an Expense Affidavit attesting to its compliance with the Expense Guidelines except for \$5,000.00 for certain expenses. Saybrook's compensation for services included a monthly financial advisory fee of \$150,000.00, which was payable beginning July 1, 2002, through January 17, 2003 and a one-time \$150,000.00 due diligence fee. As Saybrook was a flat fee Professional, Stuart Maue did not review its Application. The Committee, however, has reviewed the Saybrook Application for reasonableness. The Committee recommends that Saybrook's fees be reduced by \$47,690.00 and its expenses be reduced by \$5,000.00 as an appropriate compromise of all issues regarding Saybrook's fees and expenses. Saybrook has agreed to these reductions. Accordingly, the Committee respectfully recommends to the Court that Saybrook be awarded final compensation in the amount of \$1,144,568.06 and expenses in the amount of \$88,504.88.

5. The Committee also reviewed the expense requests of the Committee Members. The Unsecured Creditors' Committee Members are requesting \$172,247.00 in expenses and the Official Equity Committee Members are requesting \$75,195.97 in expenses. These Members volunteered their time and expertise to assist in these cases and their service on the committees is appreciated. The Committee notes that there are certain discrepancies in the expense requests from the Expense Guidelines. However, the

Committee finds them to be de minimis. Accordingly, the Committee respectfully recommends to the Court that the Unsecured Creditors' Committee's expense request of \$172,247.00 and the Official Equity Committee's expense request of \$75,195.97 be awarded in full.

6. As of the date of the filing of this report, the Committee has not resolved its concerns regarding the PriceWaterhouseCoopers LLP and the Rockwood Gemini Advisors Applications. At the January 27, 2004 Hearing on the Applications, the Committee will advise the Court of the status of any settlement discussions, and, if appropriate, will request a briefing schedule on the filing of objections to these remaining Applications.

7. Attached hereto as *Exhibit C* is a chart setting forth the recommendations of the Committee. After considering a draft of this Fee Report, the Committee adopted this Fee Report and the recommendations contained herein.
