FIFTH INTERIM AND FINAL FEE APPLICATION OF DELOITTE CONSULTING LLP FOR INTERIM AND FINAL ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES AS REORGANIZATION CONSULTANTS TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR THE INTERIM PERIOD AUGUST 1, 2003 THROUGH DECEMBER 19, 2003 AND FINAL PERIOD MARCH 22, 2002 THROUGH DECEMBER 19, 2003

Deloitte Consulting LLP ("Applicant" or "Deloitte"), as reorganization

consultant to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of National Steel Corporation ("Committee") hereby submits its Fifth Interim Fee Application for Interim Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses ("Fifth Interim Fee Application") for the period August 1, 2003 through December 19, 2003 ("Fifth Interim Fee Application Period"), pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) and 331. Deloitte hereby further submits its Final Fee Application (the "Final Fee Application" and together with the Fifth Interim Fee Application, the "Application") for the period March 22, 2003 through December 19, 2003 (the "Final Fee Application Period"). In support of this Application, Applicant states as follows:

1. On March 6, 2002 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtors each filed voluntary petitions in this Court for reorganization relief under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. § 101-1330 (as amended, the "Bankruptcy Code"). Following the Petition Date, the Debtors are continuing in the possession of their respective properties and the management of their respective businesses as debtors and debtors-in-possession pursuant to sections 1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code.

2. On March 7, 2002, this Court entered that certain Administrative Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) and 331 Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals (Docket No. 34) (the "Administrative Order"). 3. On April 23, 2002, this Court entered that certain Order Authorizing the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors to Employ and Retain Deloitte Consulting L.P. as Reorganization Consultants <u>nunc pro tunc</u> to March 22, 2002 (Docket No. 451).

4. The Debtors First Amended Joint Plan of Liquidation and accompanying Disclosure Statement dated August 14, 2003 was confirmed on October 23, 2003 and became effective on December 19, 2003.

19. The compensation and expense reimbursement sought by Deloitte arc reasonable.

A. To grant a request for compensation under sections 330 and

331 of the Bankruptcy Code, a bankruptcy court must find that such request is

reasonable. As amended in 1994, section 330 states:

In determining the amount of reasonable compensation to be awarded, the court shall consider the nature, the extent, and the value of such services, taking into account all relevant factors, including –

(i) the time spent on such services;

(ii) the rates charged for such services;

- (iii) whether the services were necessary to the administration of, or beneficial at the time at which the service was rendered toward the completion of, a case under this title;
- (iv) whether the services were performed within a reasonable amount of time commensurate with the complexity, importance, and nature of the problem, issue, or task addressed; and
- (v) whether the compensation is reasonable based on the customary compensation charged by comparably skilled practitioners in cases other than cases under this title.

B. Bankruptcy Courts in this District normally engage in the so-called "lodestar approach." The lodestar approach is a two-step process involving the calculation of a lodestar figure (the time expended multiplied by hourly rate) and adjustment of this figure based on the factors referenced above. Based on the lodestar approach, Deloitte is entitled to the compensation requested in this Application. Deloitte provided necessary and important services to the Committee in connection with these complex and time-sensitive cases. Deloitte's involvement assures the Committee of substantial ability and experience in issues of critical importance to the success of the Debtors' reorganization. The rates charged by Deloitte are reasonable and commensurate with those of the Debtors' professionals.

C. Deloitte expenses were actual and necessary in light of the work required.

20. Pursuant to the Administrative Order, copies of this Application have been served upon National Steel, section 327(a) and 327(c) counsel to the Debtors, counsel to the Post-Petition Lenders and the Committee, the United States Trustee, any other Professional

(excluding Ordinary Course Professionals) retained pursuant to Order of this Court in these cases, and on all parties that have entered their appearance pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002.

21. During the period for which compensation is sought, Deloitte has rendered or provided services solely for the Committee and not on behalf of any other entity or party in interest.

CERTIFICATION

22. The Applicant hereby certifies that it has complied with the Administrative Order dated March 7, 2002, by timely submitting its monthly statements for review to the designated Notice Parties on a monthly basis, including all monthly statements herein submitted for payment, and no objections have been received.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Applicant respectfully requests with respect to the Fifth Interim Fee Application that this Court enter an order (i) allowing and approving 100% of the fees of **\$9,045.60** and expenses of **\$21.56** for the Fifth Interim Fee Application Period, (ii) authorizing and directing payment by the Debtors of the holdback amount of fees of **\$387.66** for the period August 1, 2003 through August 31, 2003, (iii) authorizing and directing payment by the Debtors of the unpaid fees **\$5,169.00** (which includes the holdback) and expenses of **\$0.00** for the period October 1, 2003 through December 19, 2003.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Applicant respectfully further requests with respect to the Final Fee Application that this Court enter an order providing final allowance and approval of 100% of the fees [\$1,200,651.60] and expenses [\$14,300.88] for the Final Fee Application Period.
